Convention on Access to Information, Public Participation in Decision-Making and Access to Justice in Environmental







- 1 philosophy that emphasises empowerment, equity, trust and learning
- 2 Early as possible and throughout the process
- 3 Relevant stakeholders need to be analysed and represented systematically
- 4 Clear objectives agreed among stakeholders at the outset...

- 5 ...Methods should be selected and tailored to the decision-making context
- 6 Highly skilled facilitation
- 7 Integration of local and scientific knowledge
- 8 Institutionalisation of participation



# PP proces evaluation



- Suitability of Reed's criteria
  - Evaluation of the process
- Aditional participants' views and recomendations



### Conclusions



- Quality of the PP proces matters! However, it the outcomes are deleyed, this might degrade the perception of the quality of the process.
- Reed's (2008) criteria suitable for evaluation of PP in wolf conservation in Slovenia
- Concensus vs. Compromise- lack of understanding
- Need for continuation and institutionalisation of PP
- Increased social capital through learning
